

How To Use the Online Medicare Prescription Drug Plan Finder

Get Started

- 1) Go to <https://www.medicare.gov/find-a-plan/questions/home.aspx>
- 2) Enter your **zip code**, then scroll down the page and click on the orange "**Find Plans**" box
- 3) Select any Medicare/Medicaid coverages you currently have by clicking the appropriate box(es)
- 4) Indicate if you currently receive financial assistance from Medicare or the state to pay your Medicare prescription drug costs
- 5) Click on the orange "**Continue to Plan Results**" box

Add Your Prescriptions

- 6) Enter the name of your prescription (in the orange box at the top left portion of the screen) and then click on "**Find my drug**"
- 7) Select the appropriate dosage/ frequency information and click the "**Add Drug and Dosage**" box
- 8) Repeat Step 6 - 7 until you have entered all of your medications.

Before moving on to step 9, please write down the information located on the top right section of the screen (Drug List ID, Password Date and Zip code) so that you can retrieve your medication list in the future.

- 9) Review your drug information and click on the orange "**My Drug List is Complete**" box at the bottom of the screen

Select Your Pharmacy and Review Available Plans

- 10) The default list will be for pharmacies in your zip code. If you do not wish to choose a specific pharmacy click on the "I don't want to add pharmacies now" button on the left side of the screen. An alert box will pop up, to move forward click on "Skip Pharmacy Selection".
- 11) You will need to select which plans you would like to see. Click in the first box that indicates "Prescription Drug Plans" and then click on the orange "**Continue to Plan Results**" button.
- 12) Your plan comparison chart will appear in order of the least annual estimated cost. You can click on the plans to review. (You also can select up to 3 plans to do a side by side comparison)
- 13) For a detailed plan overview of the Part D plans click on the Plan name (highlighted in blue)
